I am a medical doctor and PhD student employed at Steno Diabetes Center North Denmark and Aalborg University. I have gathered clinical experience with diabetes working with patients hospitalized due to diabetic complications as well as in the outpatient clinic and in the multidisciplinary foot team. My brief scientific career has been dedicated to research in the field of diabetes with a special interest in diabetic neuropathy, which is also the centre of my ongoing PhD study, where early detection of small fibre neuropathy and aetiology of painful neuropathy are some of the main themes.

### C. Contributions to Science:
